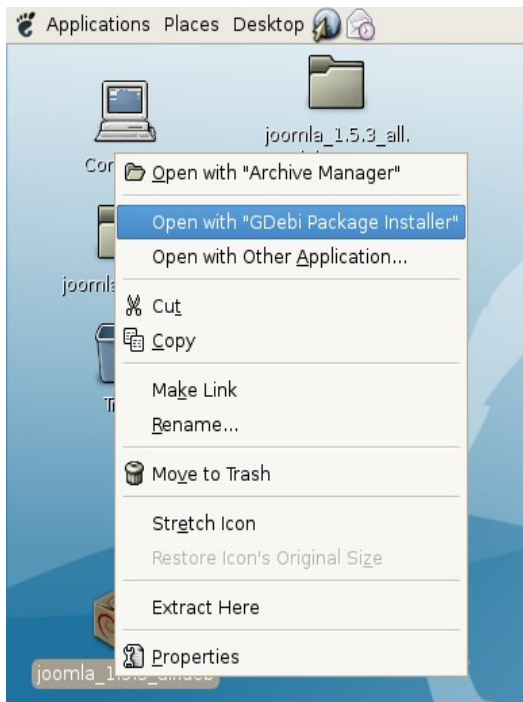


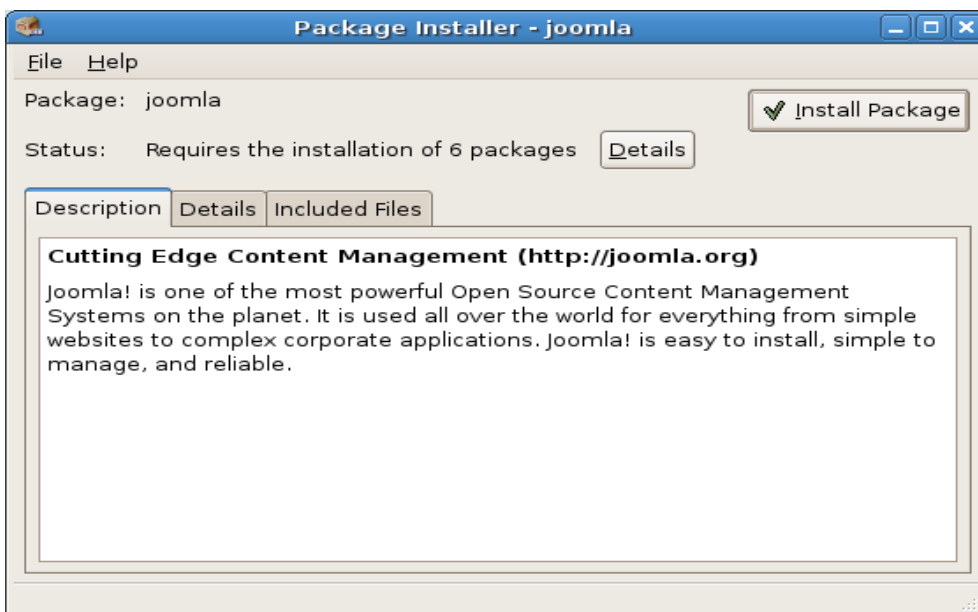
PANDUAN INSTALASI JOOMLA 1.5.3 DI DEBIAN

2. Open paket joomla dengan Gdebi

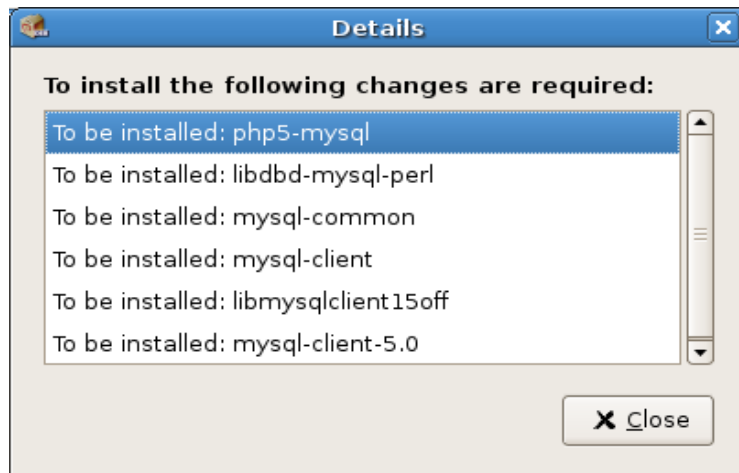

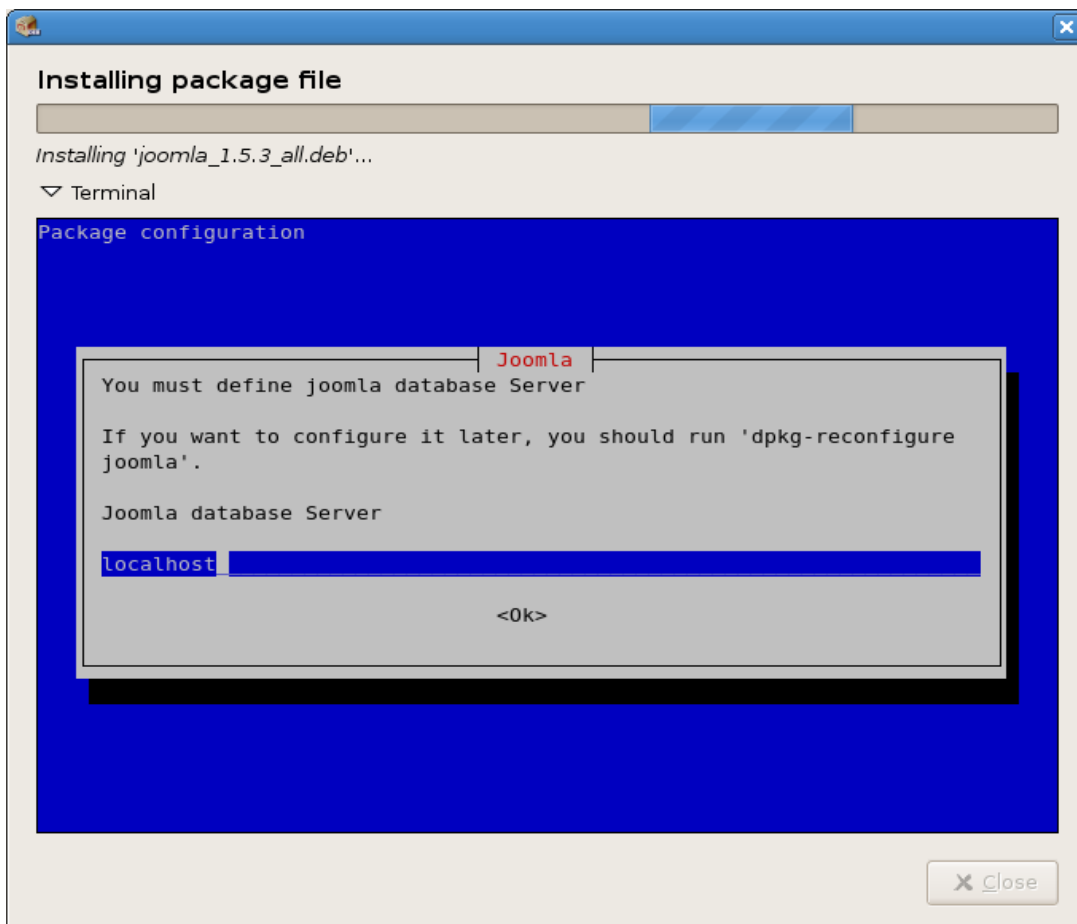


Jika ada yang paket yang merupakan syarat joomla belum anda instal maka akan muncul tampilan sbb :

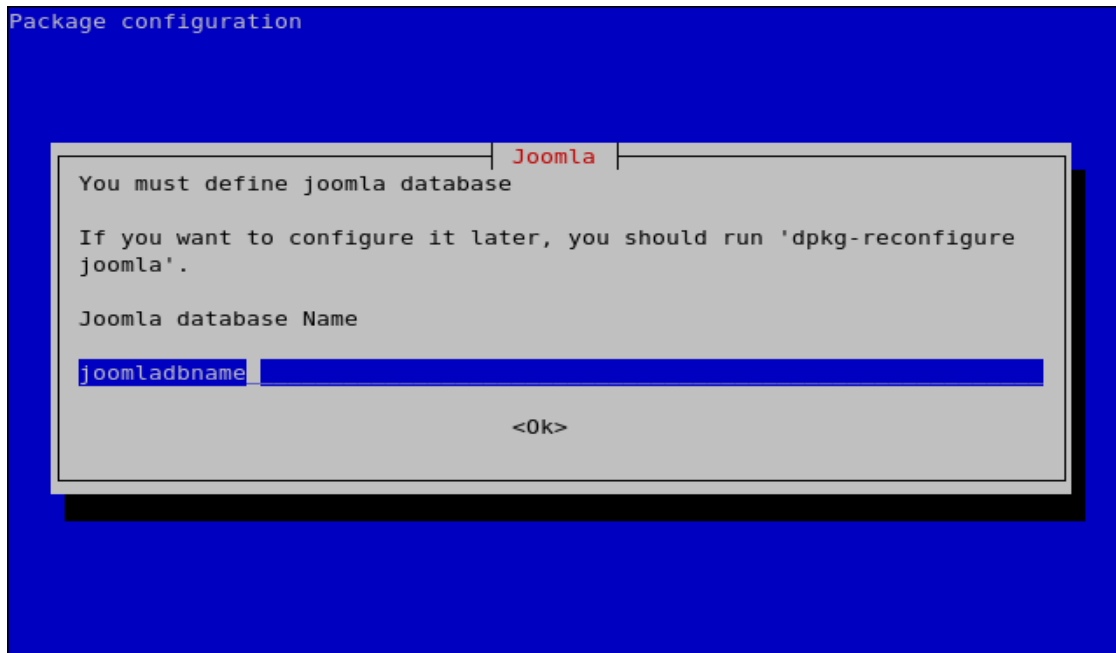

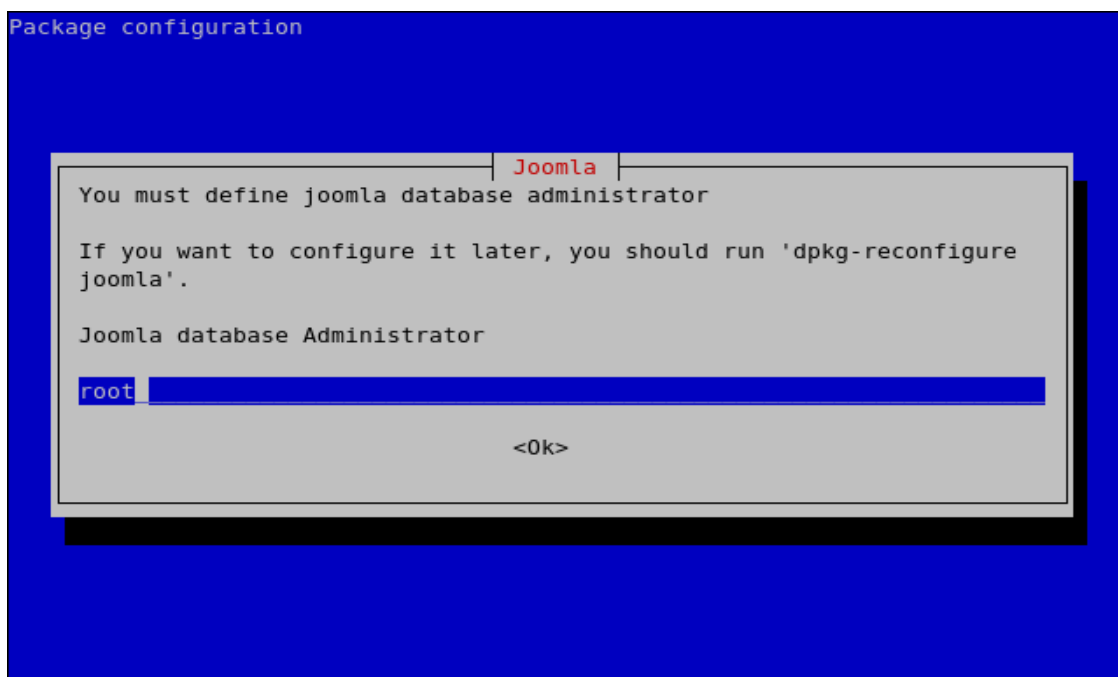
Isilah dengan letak database MySQL server anda berada. (Database bisa berada di tempat lain, tidak harus dalam 1 komputer. Jika database dan webserver berada dalam 1 komputer maka **anda harus instal MySQL server terlebih dahulu** (apt -get install MySQL)



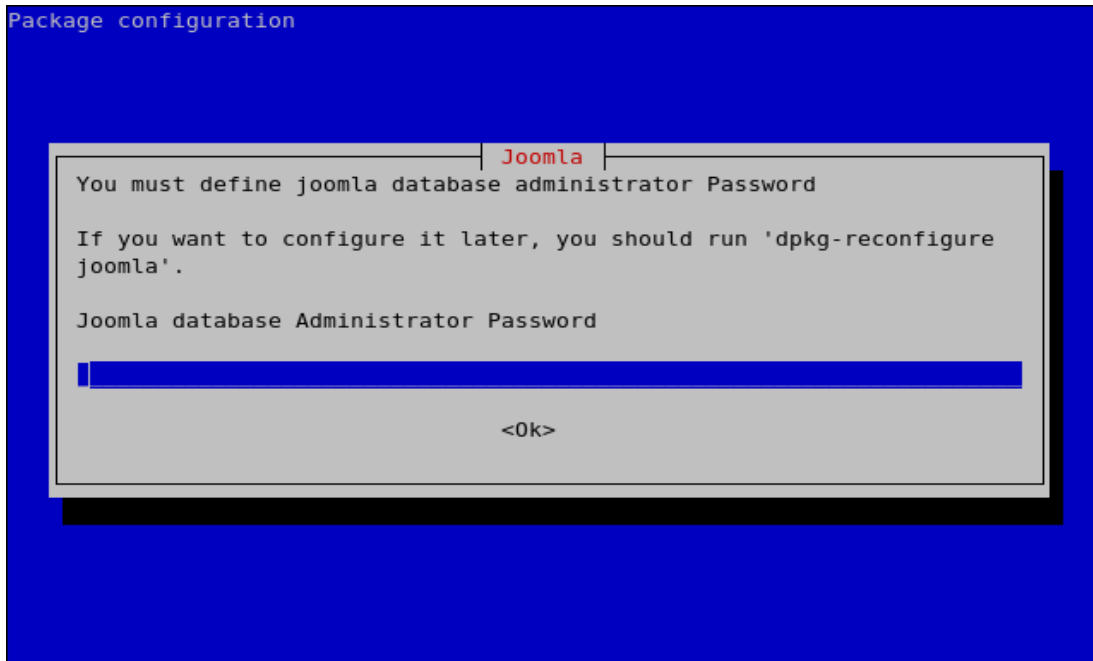
Masukkan nama database :



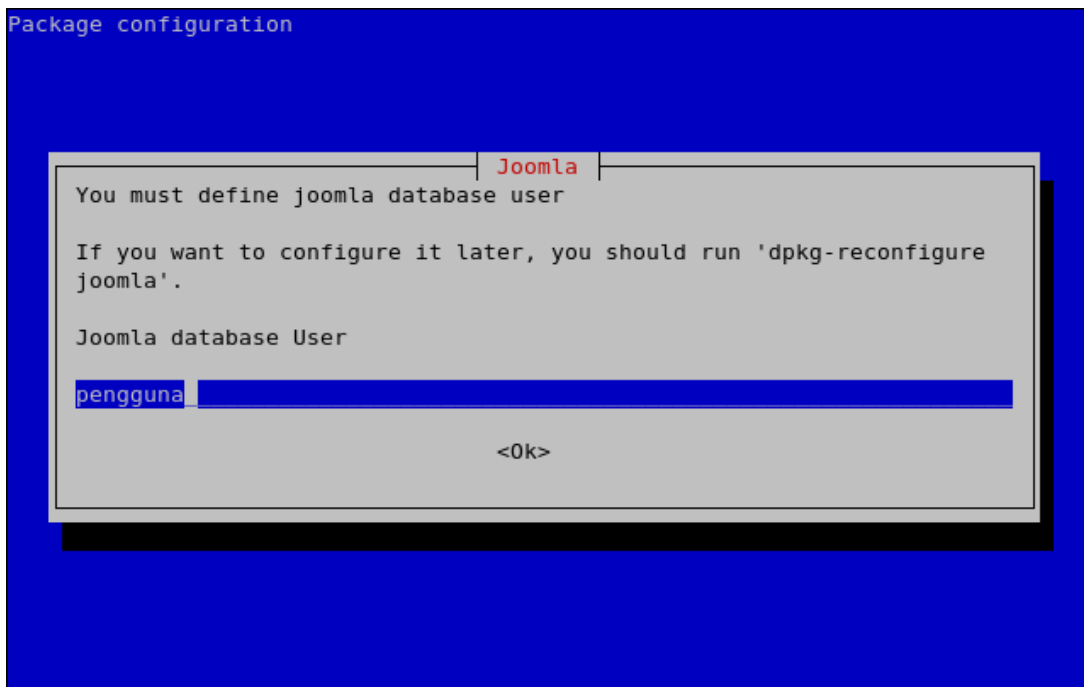
Masukkan nama administrator dari database MySQL anda. Administrator ini dapat membuat user baru yang akan diberi hak untuk mengatur database Joomla. Biasanya MySQL secara default mempunyai user root sebagai administrator



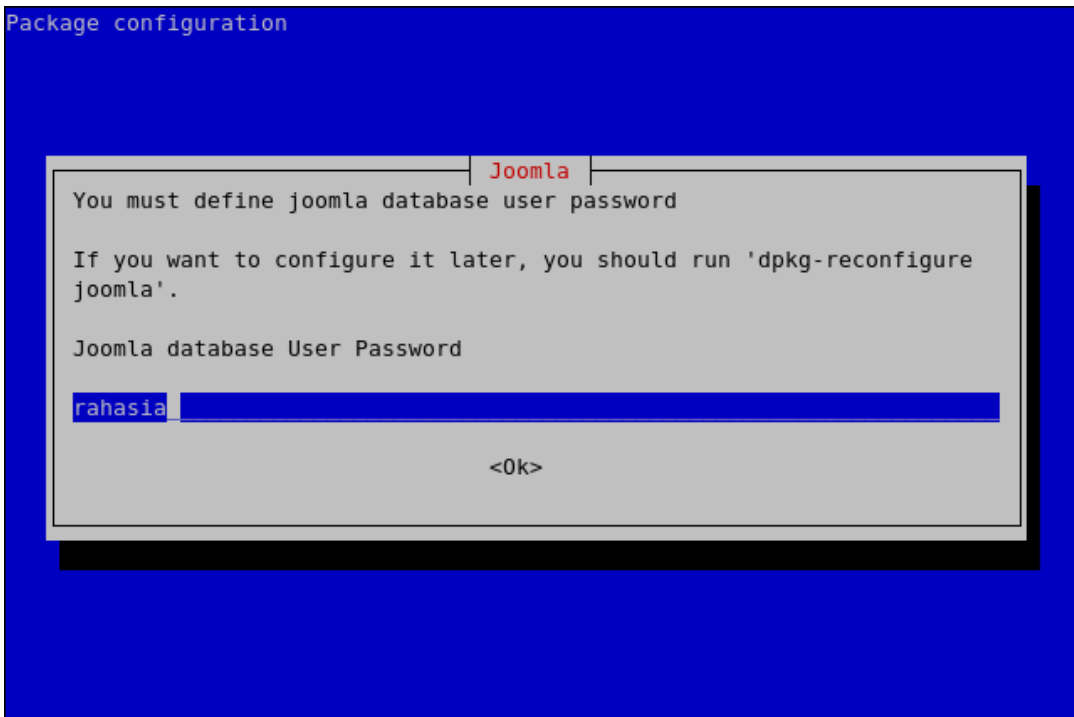
Masukkan password administrator, jika anda baru saja menginstall MySQL (Fresh) biasanya password root belum diisi (blank)



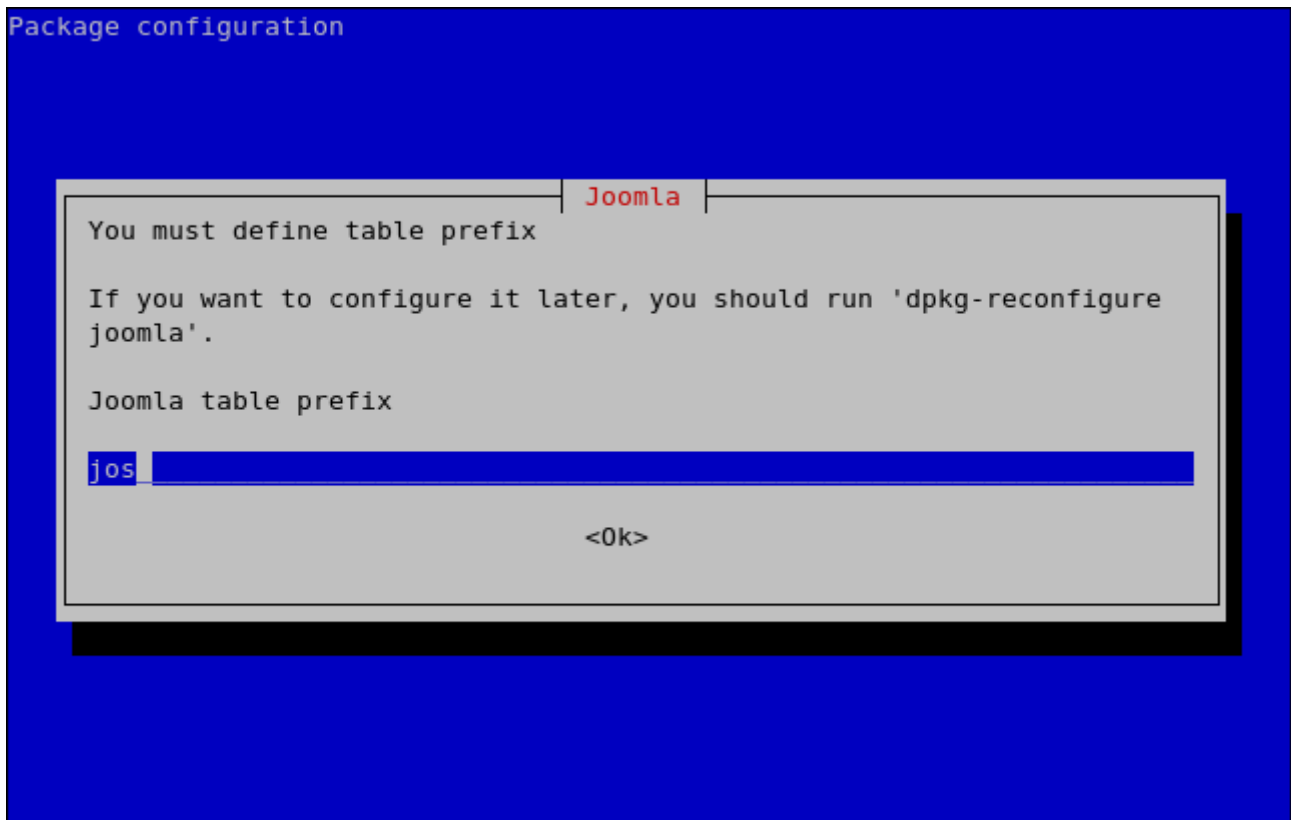
Masukkan nama user MySQL yang akan diberi hak untuk CREATE, DELETE, UPDATE database Joomla. User yang telah ada sebelumnya juga dapat dimasukkan, jika user tersebut belum ada maka akan secara otomatis dibuatkan.



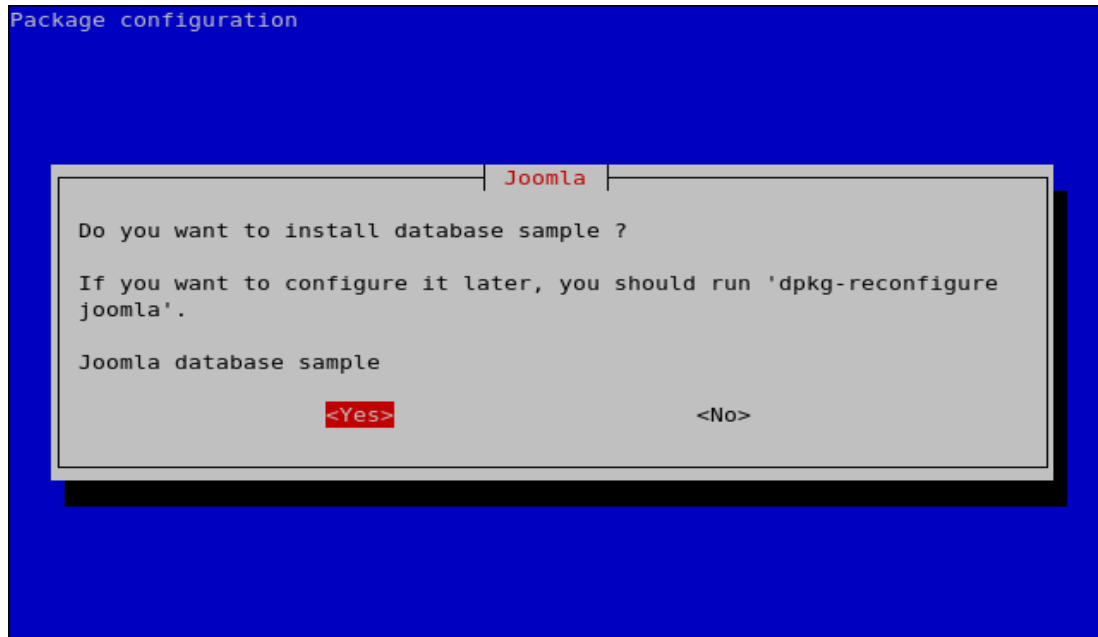
Masukkan password user tsb.



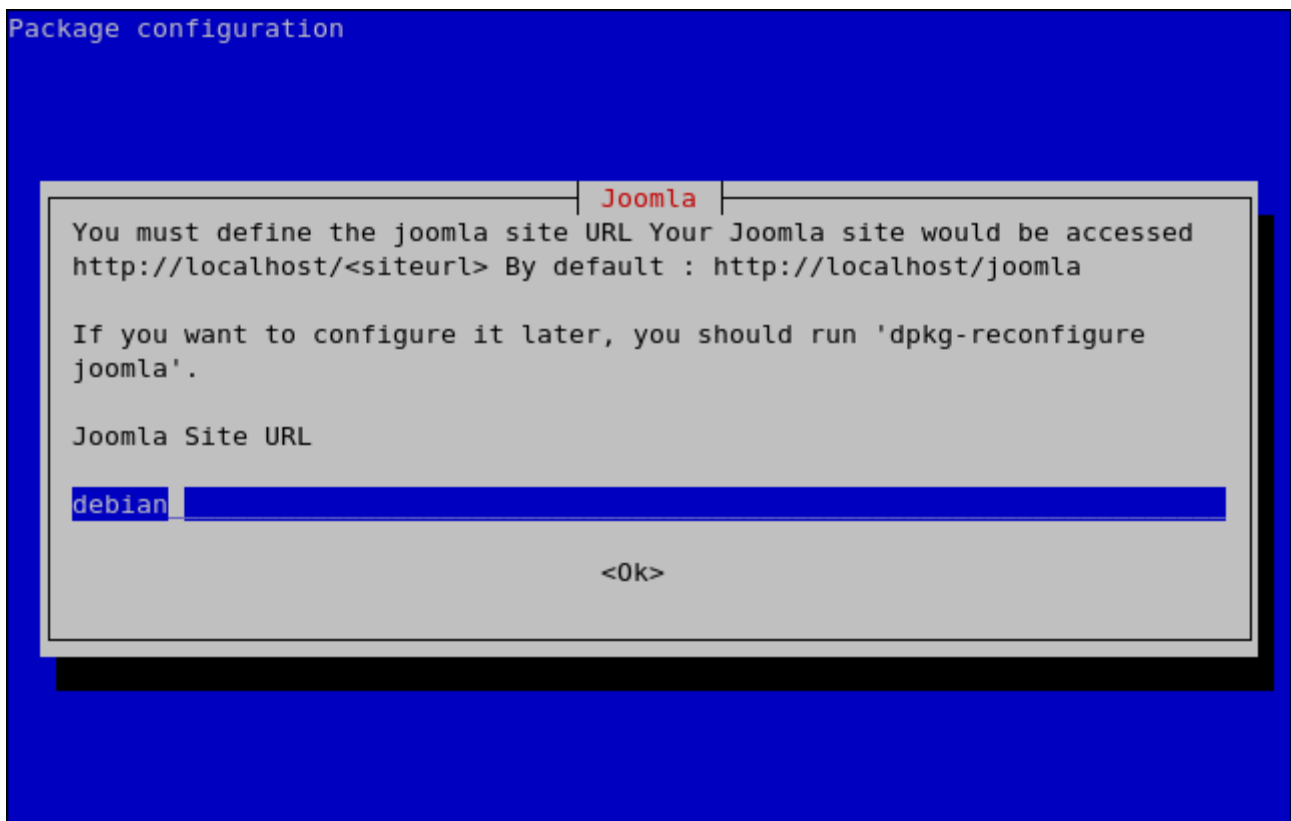
Masukkan beberapa karakter di depan nama tabel pada database joomla (Contoh : jika prefix anda **jos** maka semua tabel dalam database joomla akan bernama **jos_namatabel**, jika prefix **deb** maka semua nama tabel akan **deb_namatabel**)



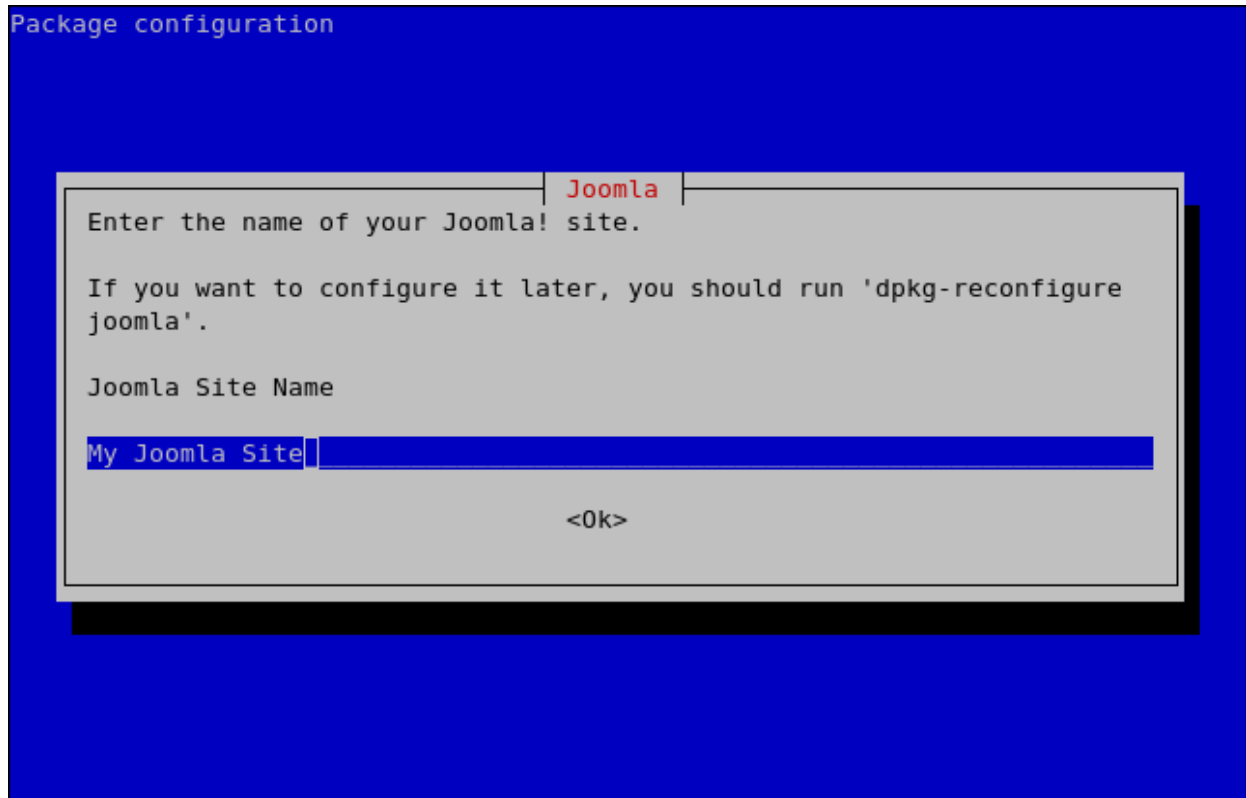

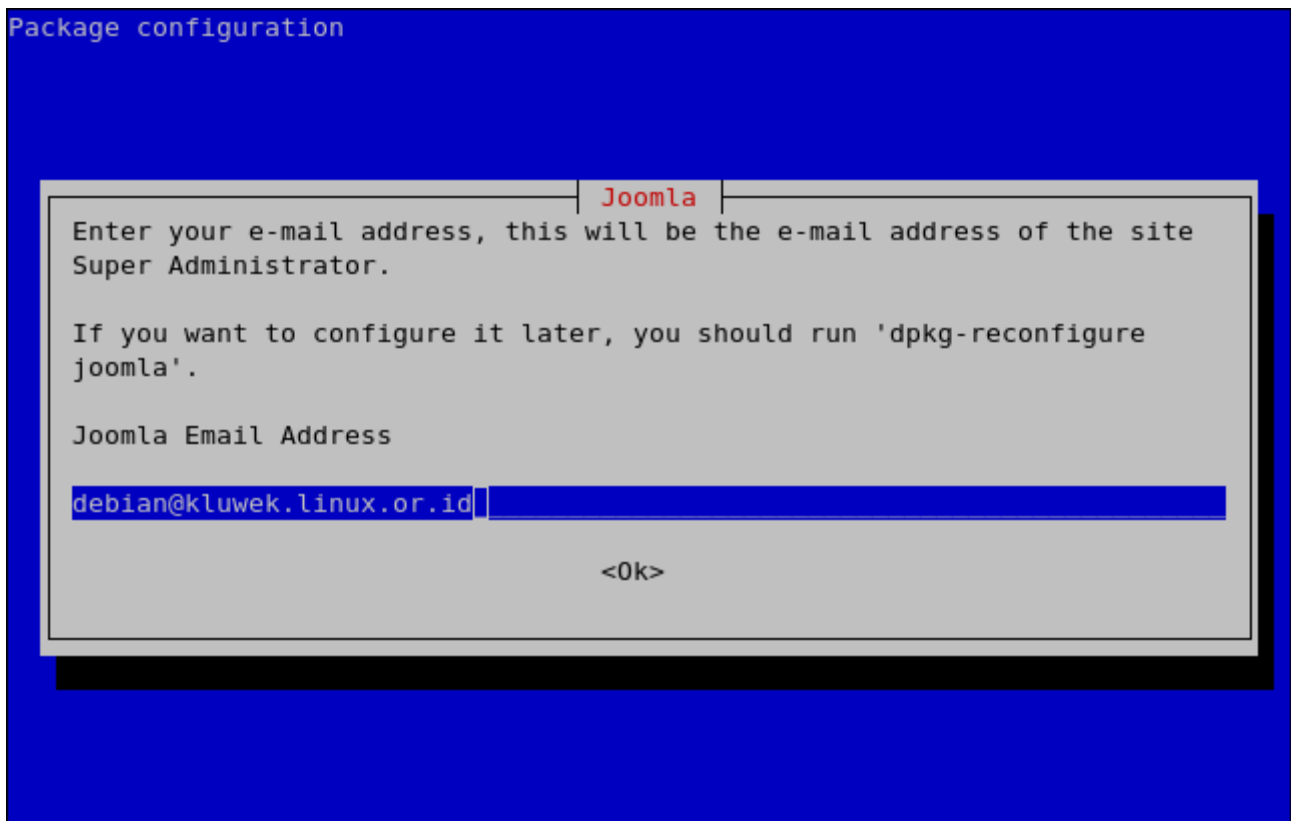

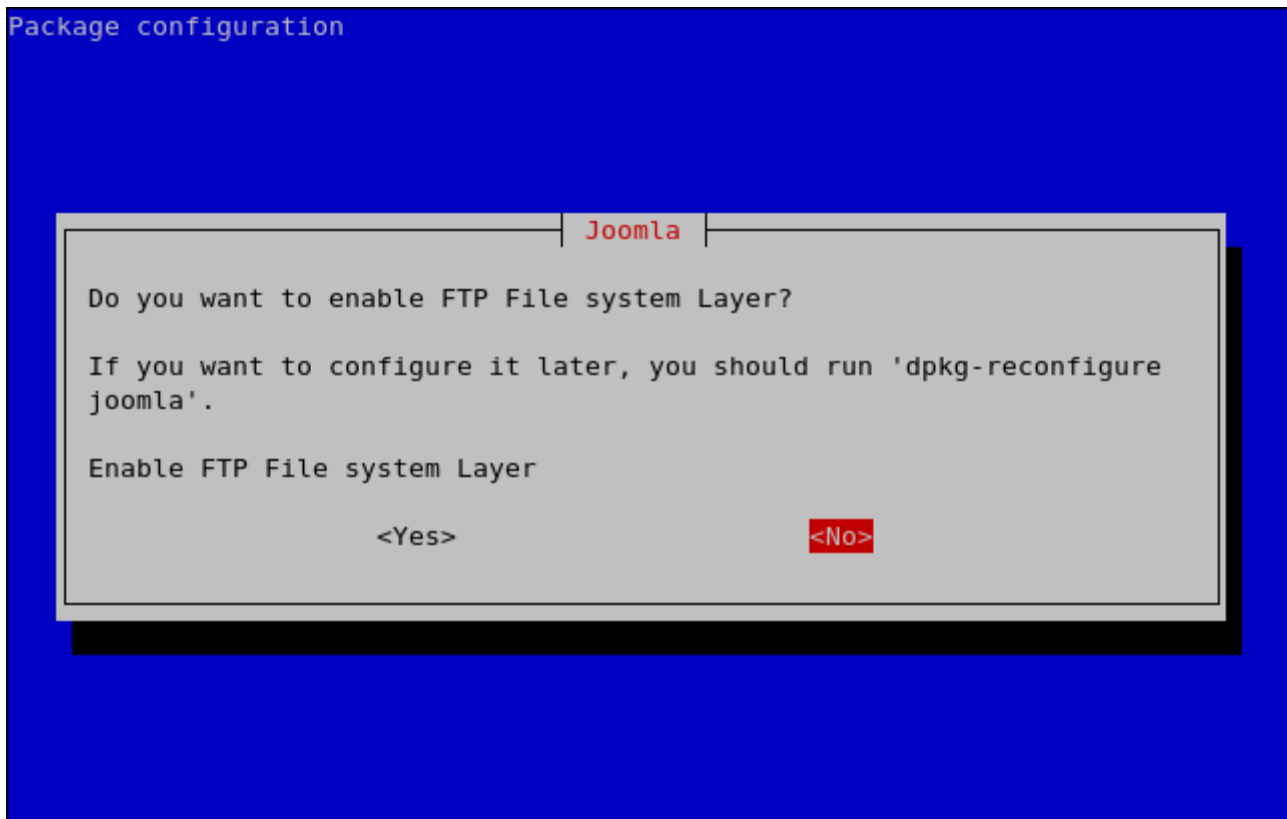
Masukkan nama site anda, misalnya Debian Site :)



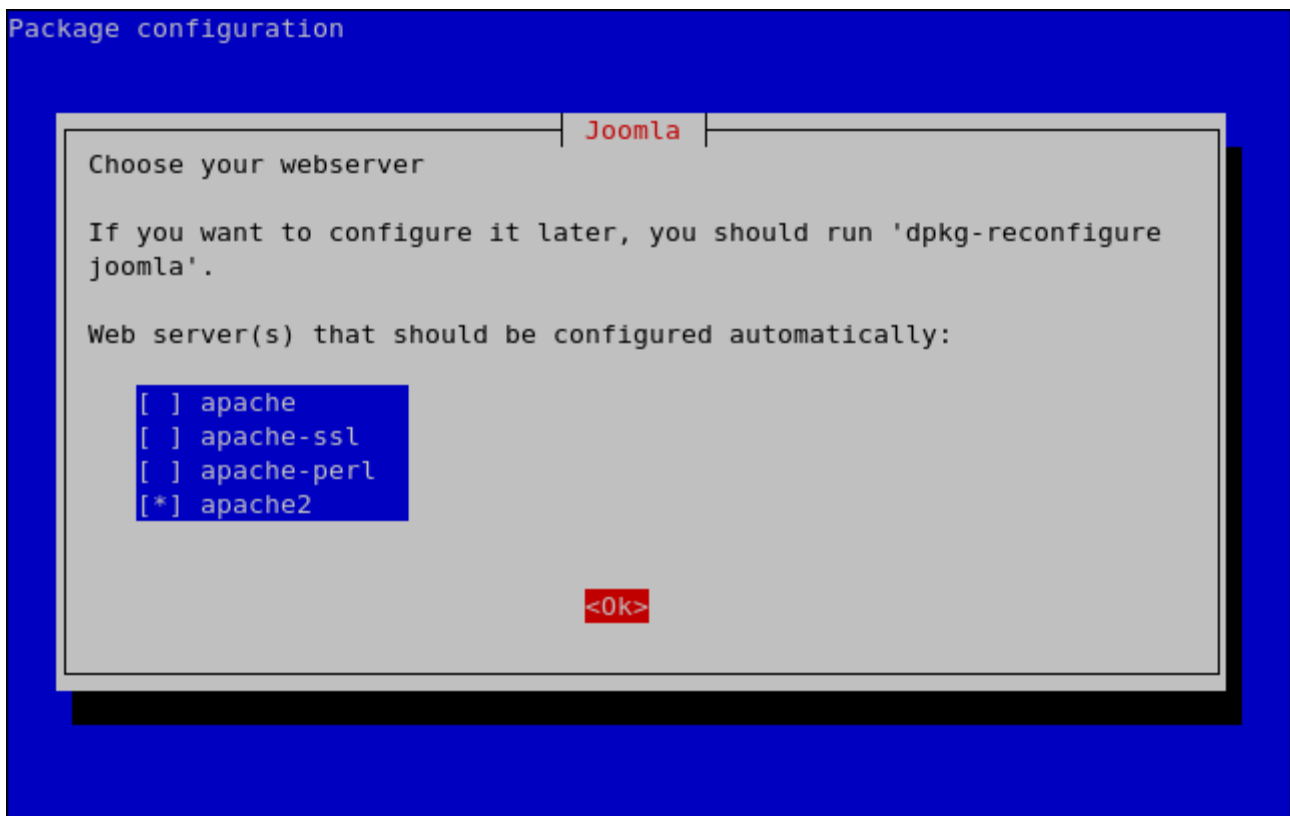
Masukkan nama email yang akan memberikan pesan pada sistem joomla. Misalnya Konfirmasi pendaftaran user.



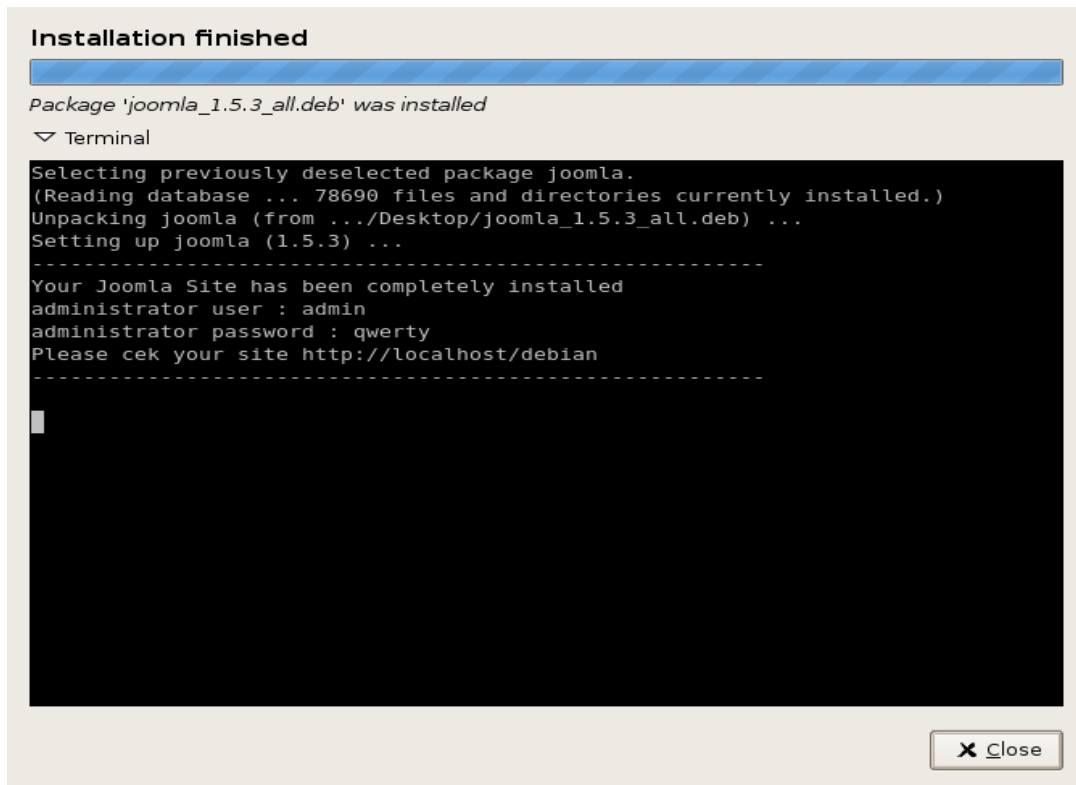
Jika kita ingin mengaktifkan fungsi ftp pada debian. Sehingga anda dapat mengakses <ftp://localhost/debian>.

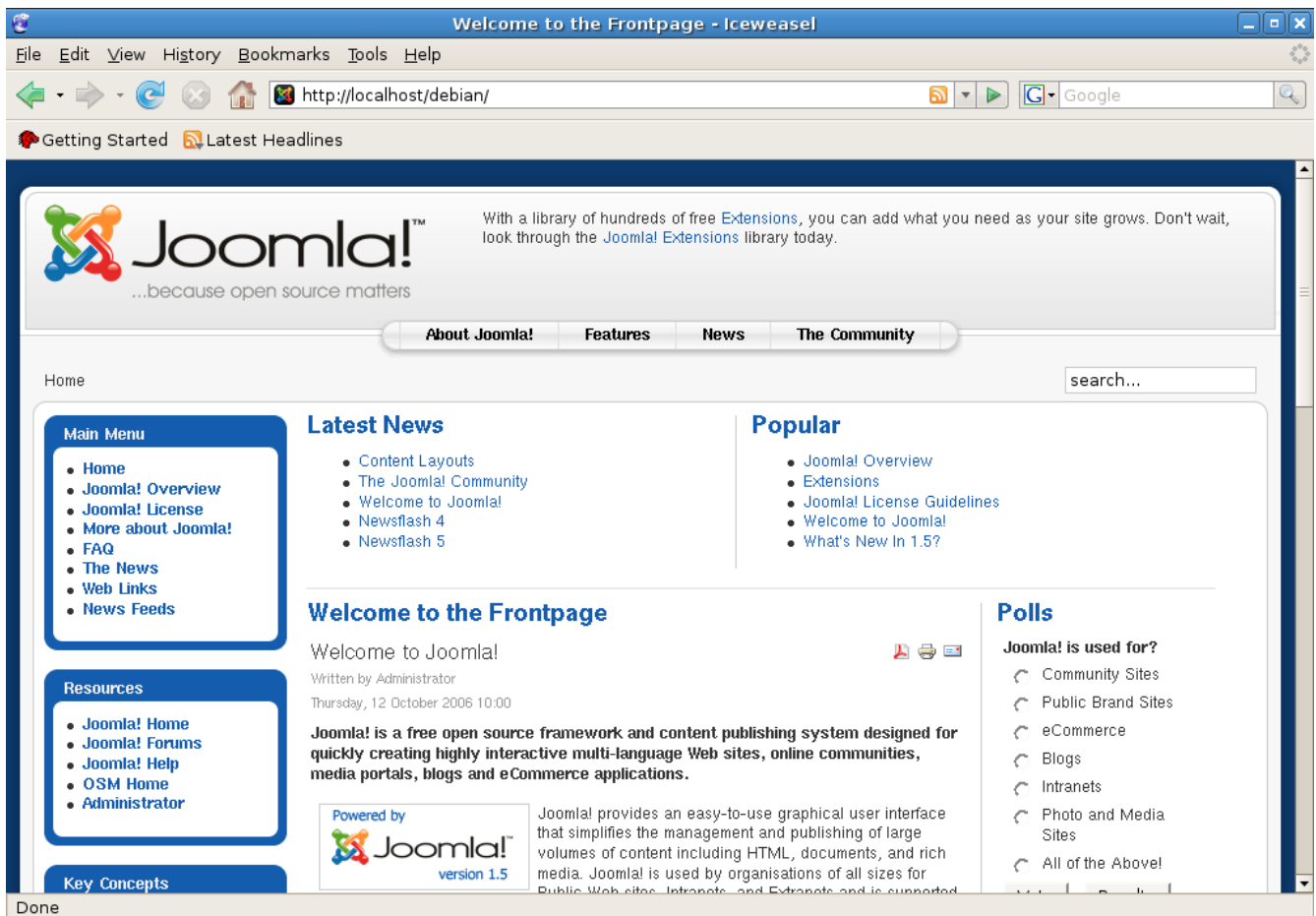


Jika instalasi berhasil akan terlihat tampilan spt di bawah ini :






